


## Take Me Out to the Ballgame

newsletter, we have obtained a five-year lease for an apartment complex and moved a total of six families into the apartments, and

we hope to add three to four more qualified families by the end of June. It is so wonderful to be able to give families an opportunity to continue what they started at My Father's House.

Stepping Stone Apartments is located on 92nd and Burnside. In case you missed the last newsletter, here's how it works. We are leasing apartments for our residents who have finished the classes and opportunities at the shelter. The next step would be to obtain affordable housing... but there are many

obstacles to overcome. One of them is poor rental history. It is becoming increasingly hard to find affordable housing for people with evictions or who have any type of criminal background.

Plus, sometimes they just need a little more encouragement and class time to help them be fully ready to embark on their own. Having our own "next step" program is the perfect solution! And now we have it in the form of this 18-unit apartment complex.

Still, we are not finished. Now that we have the apartments (a retired college dorm), we need to

complete eight more kitchens in the units. If you are skilled at hanging cupboards, putting in countertops or laying vinyl floors, we'd love to have your help!
